Professor Tye did NOT make me feel comfortable asking questions in his class since he viewed as students who knew nothing about philosophy and he was a God with all the answers. On the other hand, Zach was an excellent TA. He made me comfortable asking questions and he ACTUALLY seemed like he cared about helping students. My grade will most likely be an A in this class, NOT because of Professor Tye, but because of my TA Zach.
