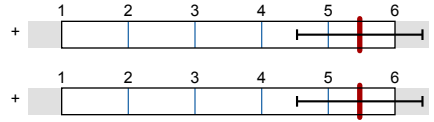

Global Index



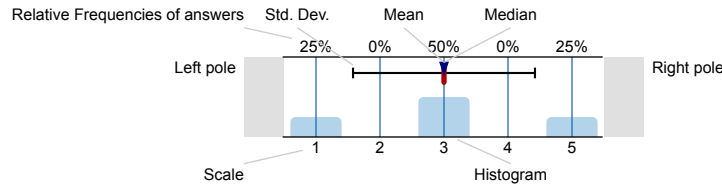

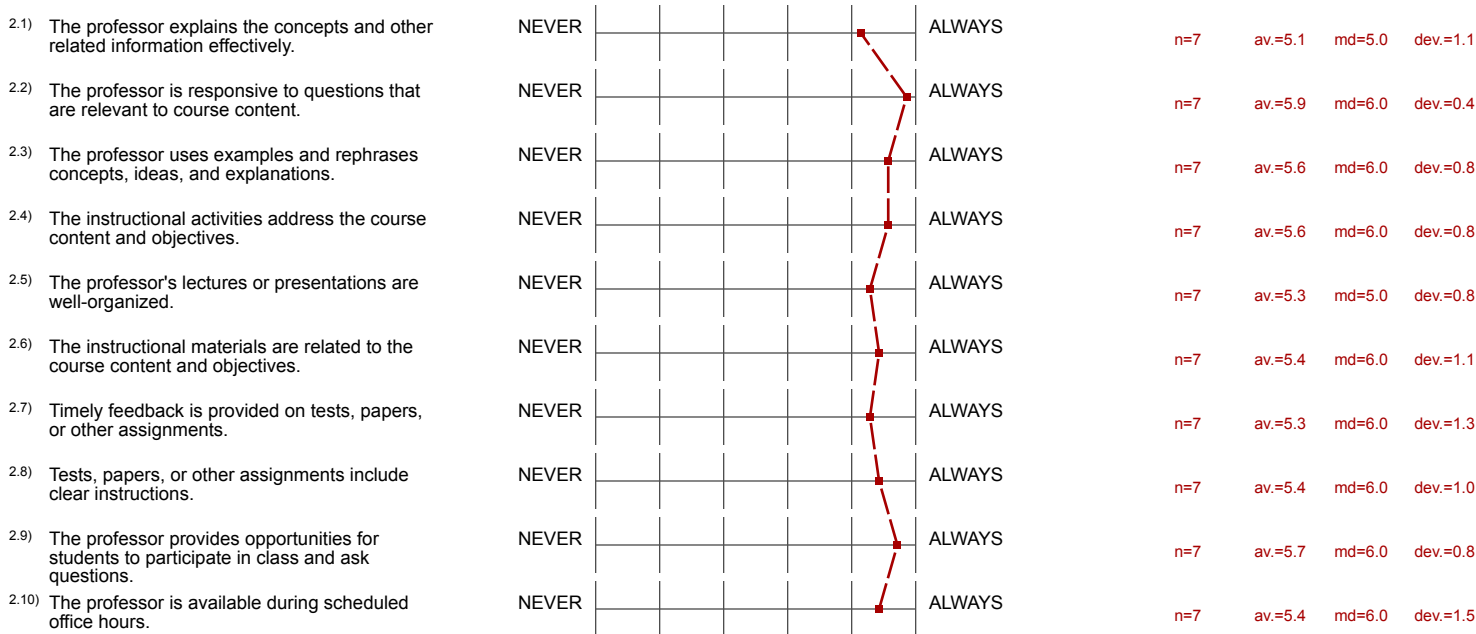
- I appreciate that I have been able to recover from surgery, the dissolving stitches DID NOT HEAL RIGHT
